Once all are in place, the officers join hands except with the New Members At the appropriate time, Officers and Members raise their hands and then drop each set of clasped hands one at a time. After dropping both hands, members assume the Attitude of Prayer until the completion of the prayer and song. Chaplain stands if kneeling at the end of the prayer but remains in the center of the circle Conductresses leave the Circle first by countermarching just outside of the Labyrinth and march to the East line in a straight line.
